Minnesota Veterans 4 Veterans Trust Fund (V4V) approve a \$32,500.00 Grant to assist Minnesota Veterans

At the **June 2021** Minnesota Veterans 4 Veterans Trust fund monthly meeting, the following grant was approved by the eight-member board of directors:

Independent Lifestyles,Inc, was awarded \$32,500.00 by V4V Trust Fund for the 2021 year to provide retreats for 50 Veterans and/or family members. Each retreat costs approximately \$650 per person for a total of \$32,500 per year. They will offer a variety of retreats that include topics ranging from: PTSD, Community reintegration, suicide prevention, healthy relationships, community resources, coping with trauma, resiliency and much more. Camp Bliss is located on 48 acres and three lakes in Walker, MN. It provides the nature, the serenity and the security Veterans need in addition to high quality and comfortable accommodations. Retreats range from 2-4 days in length.
